SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

UDTS invites qualified applicants for the Presidential Scholarship, the Rural/Small Church Ministry Scholarship and our Presbyterian College Scholarship. These scholarships are offered in addition to our need-based scholarship policy of granting up to 100% tuition grants for students from the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and up to 50% tuition grants for students from other denominations.

Presidential Scholarship

This scholarship recognizes an applicant's academic ability and commitment to the life and mission of the church in the amount of tuition, fees, and the equivalent of a single room and board for **each** of a student's three years of study provided the student maintains a 3.4 G.P.A. Criteria which the selection committee uses in naming recipient(s) of the scholarship are:

- ◆ Achievement in undergraduate and graduate-level academic programs
- ◆ Evidence of a strong commitment to the Church and its mission
- ◆ Promise for the parish ministry
- ◆ Evidence of active Christian faith and practice
- ◆ A citizen or permanent resident of the United States

Rural/Small Church Ministry Scholarship

Recognizing that it is one of our strengths to prepare women and men for ministry in the small, often rural church, this scholarship supports students who are committed to beginning their ministry in the small church. The amount of this grant is full-tuition plus \$1,000 which can be applied towards academic or living costs. The grant is renewable for up to 3 years. Criteria which the selection committee uses in naming recipient(s) of the scholarship are:

- ◆ Evidence of a strong commitment to the rural/small church
- ◆ Promise for the parish ministry
- ◆ Evidence of active Christian faith and practice
- ◆ A citizen or permanent resident of the United States

Presbyterian College Scholarship

Recognizing our relationship to Presbyterian colleges, we offer full-tuition grants, fees and medical insurance (equivalent to the amount for a single student) for the first year of study. Students from any denomination are eligible. Criteria which the selection committee uses in naming recipient(s) of the scholarship are:

- ◆ Graduate of a Presbyterian College who enrolls within one year of graduation
- ◆ Achievement in undergraduate academic programs
- ◆ Evidence of active Christian faith and practice
- ◆ A citizen or permanent resident of the United States
